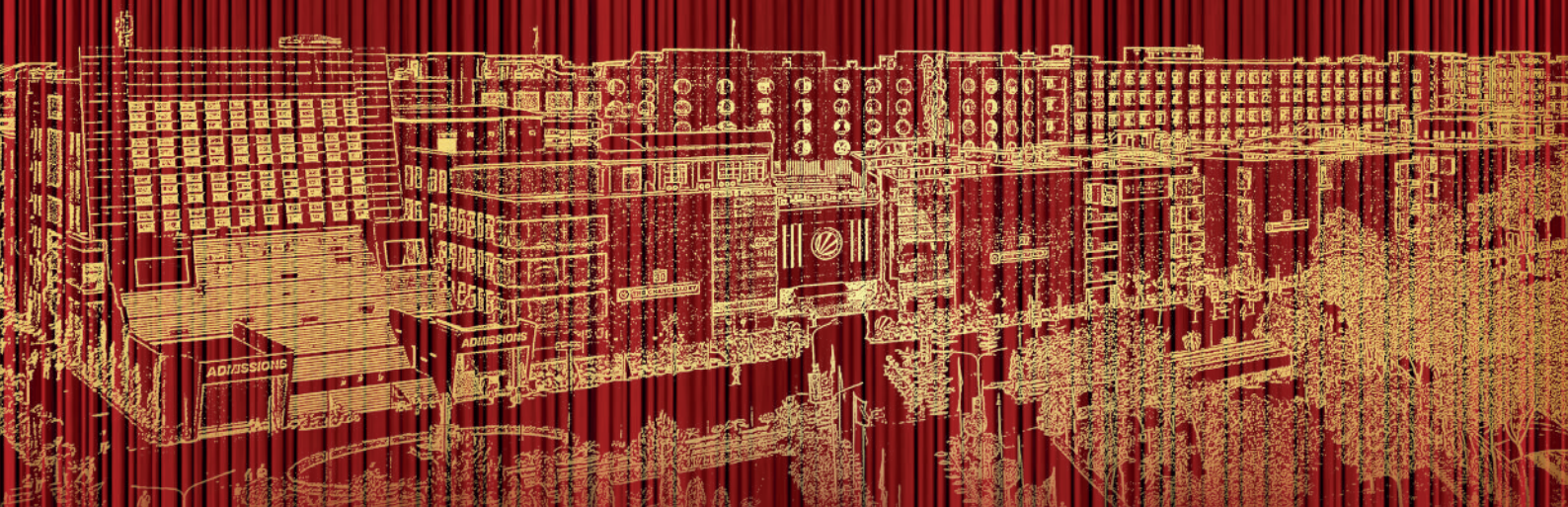

It owes its origin to the foresight and initiative of two British Chemists, namely, Professor J. L. Simonsen and Professor P.S. MacMahon. It occurred to them that scientific research in India might be stimulated if an annual meeting of research workers somewhat on the lines of the British Association for the Advancement of Science could be arranged.

From this modest beginning in 1914 with 105 members and 35 papers communicated for reading at the first session, ISCA has grown into a strong fraternity with more than 60000 members till date. There are now 14 sections namely Agriculture and Forestry Sciences, Animal, Veterinary and Fishery Sciences, Anthropological and Behavioural Sciences (including Archaeology and Psychology & Educational Sciences), Chemical Sciences, Earth System Sciences, Engineering Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Information and Communication Science & Technology (including Computer Sciences), Material Sciences, Mathematical Sciences (including Statistics), Medical Sciences (including Physiology), New Biology (including Biochemistry, Biophysics & Molecular Biology and Biotechnology), Physical Sciences, Plant Sciences and one Committee Science & Society.

Registration Guidelines

- Delegates/Presenters of papers must be ISCA members and confirm their ISCA membership (Membership Form enclosed for reference).
- Senior Scientists/ Delegates aged 65+ receive 50% off on Registration fees.
- Companions of Council Members/ Recorders/ Chapter Conveners must also register (gratis).
- Invited Speakers will be registered by the host institution based on the list received from ISCA.
- The registration fee includes 109th ISC participation, Congress Kit, and Food Coupons (valid from Jan 3-5). Members having voting rights will get hospitality for Jan 6 also.
- For accompanying person(s) (of age 12 years or above), the charges will be ₹1500/- for Indian and \$100 for Foreign delegates per head. They will not receive a Congress kit.
- Student applicants must provide a valid student certificate from their College/ University.

- Dormitory per head for either complete or partial Congress days 2nd to 5th Jan 2024 : ₹500

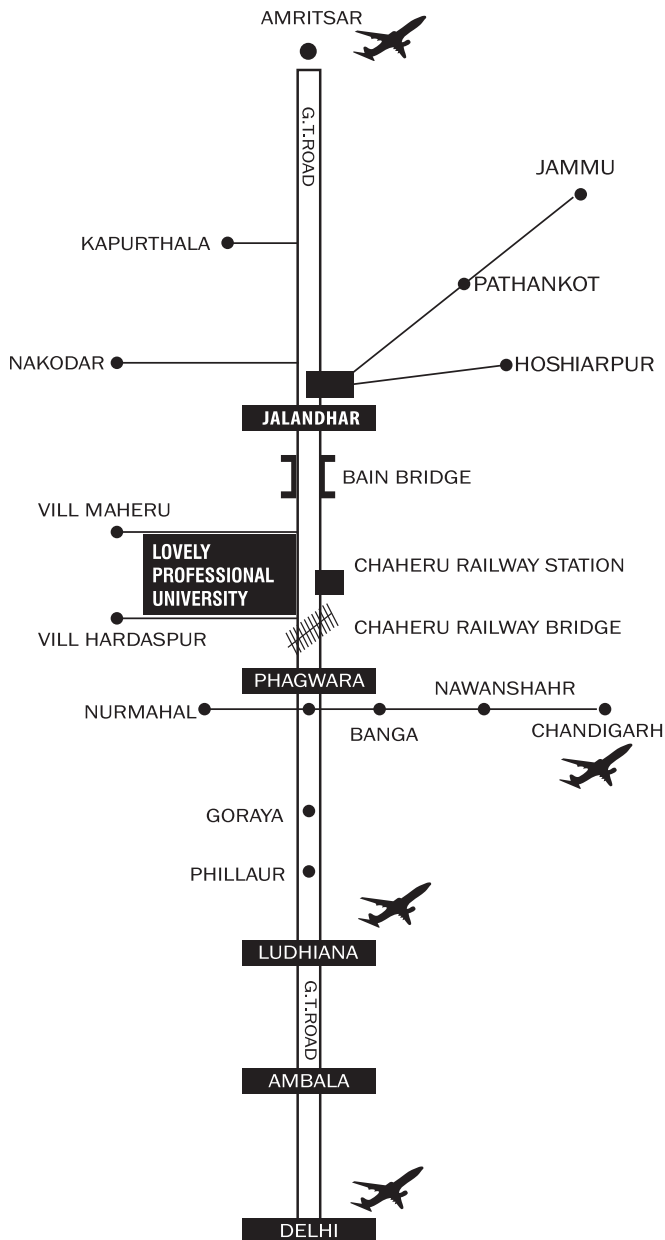

How to reach us



By Air: The nearest airports are in Amritsar and Chandigarh, one can take a flight till there and catch a bus or private taxi to reach LPU.

By Train: There is good rail connectivity from New Delhi to LPU. The nearest railway stations to LPU are Phagwara, Jalandhar City and Jalandhar Cantt.

By Road: To reach LPU from New Delhi, one can take the bus to Amritsar/ Jalandhar/ Pathankot/ Jammu or Batala and get down at LPU main gate after crossing Phagwara Bus Stand.

- 7 km from Jalandhar Cantt Railway Station
- 15 km from Jalandhar City Railway Station
- 45 km from Ludhiana City
- 80 km from Amritsar Airport
- 130 km from Chandigarh Airport

Jalandhar (15kms)

Dharamshala (158kms)

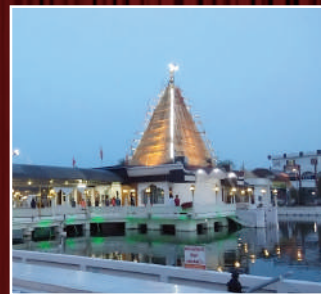
